










Total number of adult learners in further education by age band (2019/20)




Trend in adult learners (19+) in further education by age band (2017/18 – 2019/20)


Percentage change of adults (19+) in further education between 2017/18 & 2019/20 by age band




Percentage of adult learners (19+) in further education by age band and sex (2019/20)




Total number of adult learners (19+) in further education by ethnicity (2019/20)






Percentage change of adults (19+) in further education between 2017/18 & 2019/20 by ethnicity


Total number of adult learners (19+) in further education by sex (2019/20)




Trend in learners in further education by sex

Percentage change of adults (19+) in further education between 2017/18 and 2019/20 by sex






Total number of adult learners (19+) in further education by disability (2019/20)






Total number of learners in local authority community learning by year

Total number of learning activities in local authority community learning by year


3.2 Age Band







Total number of learners in local authority community learning by age band (2019/20)

Percentage change of local authority community learning between 2017/18 & 2019/20 by age band







Percentage of local authority community learners by age band and sex (2019/20)


Total number of learners in local authority community learning by ethnicity (2019/20)





Percentage change of local authority community learning between 2017/18 & 2019/20 by ethnicity






Total number of learners in local authority community learning by sex (2019/20)




Trend in learners in local authority community learning by sex




Percentage change of local authority community learning between 2017/18 and 2019/20 by sex


Total number of learners in local authority community learning by disability (2019/20)


Percentage change of local authority community learning between 2017/18 and 2019/20 by disability


Total number of learning activities in local authority community learning by subject area (2019/20)

Percentage change of learning activities in local authority community learning between 2017/18 and 2019/20 by subject area





Total number of learners in local authority community learning by local authority (2015/16)





Total number of learners in local authority community learning by local authority (2016/17)





Total number of learners in local authority community learning by local authority (2017/18)




